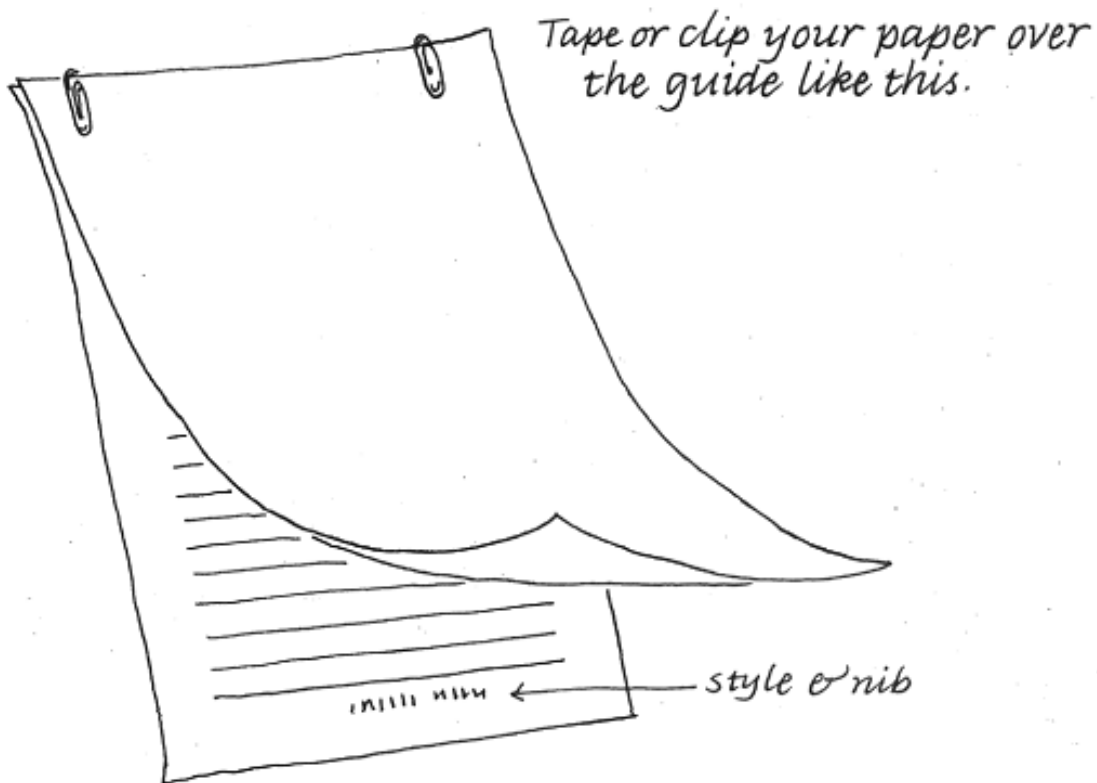


# GUIDES

The guides on the following pages are designed to be used underneath the paper on which you are lettering. The lines can be seen through most standard writing and printing papers. Do not letter directly on these guides; that will render them useless.

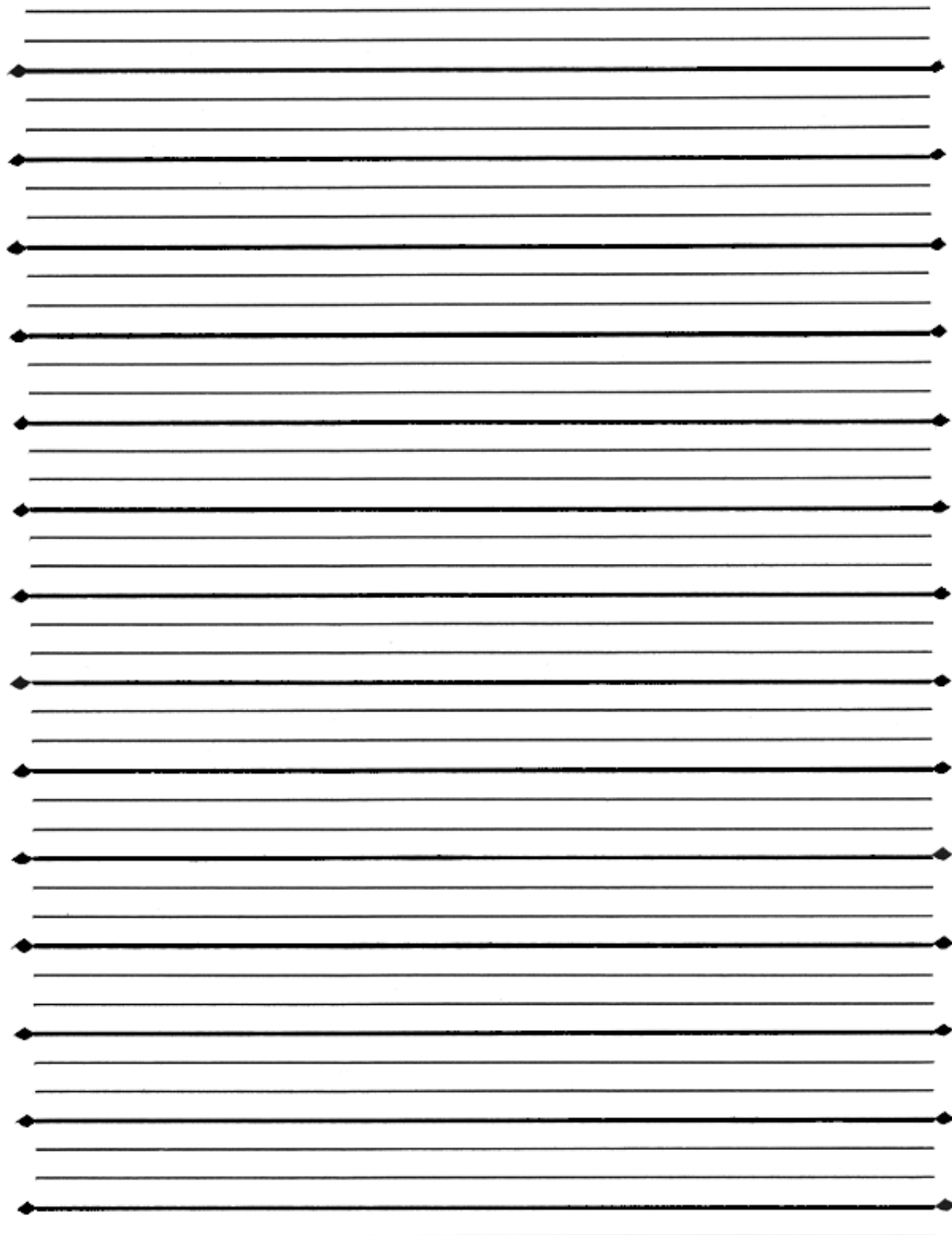
Each guide identifies the calligraphic style and the size nib for which it is to be used. For example, *Italic B2* means the *Italic* style is to be written with the *B2* fountain pen nib.



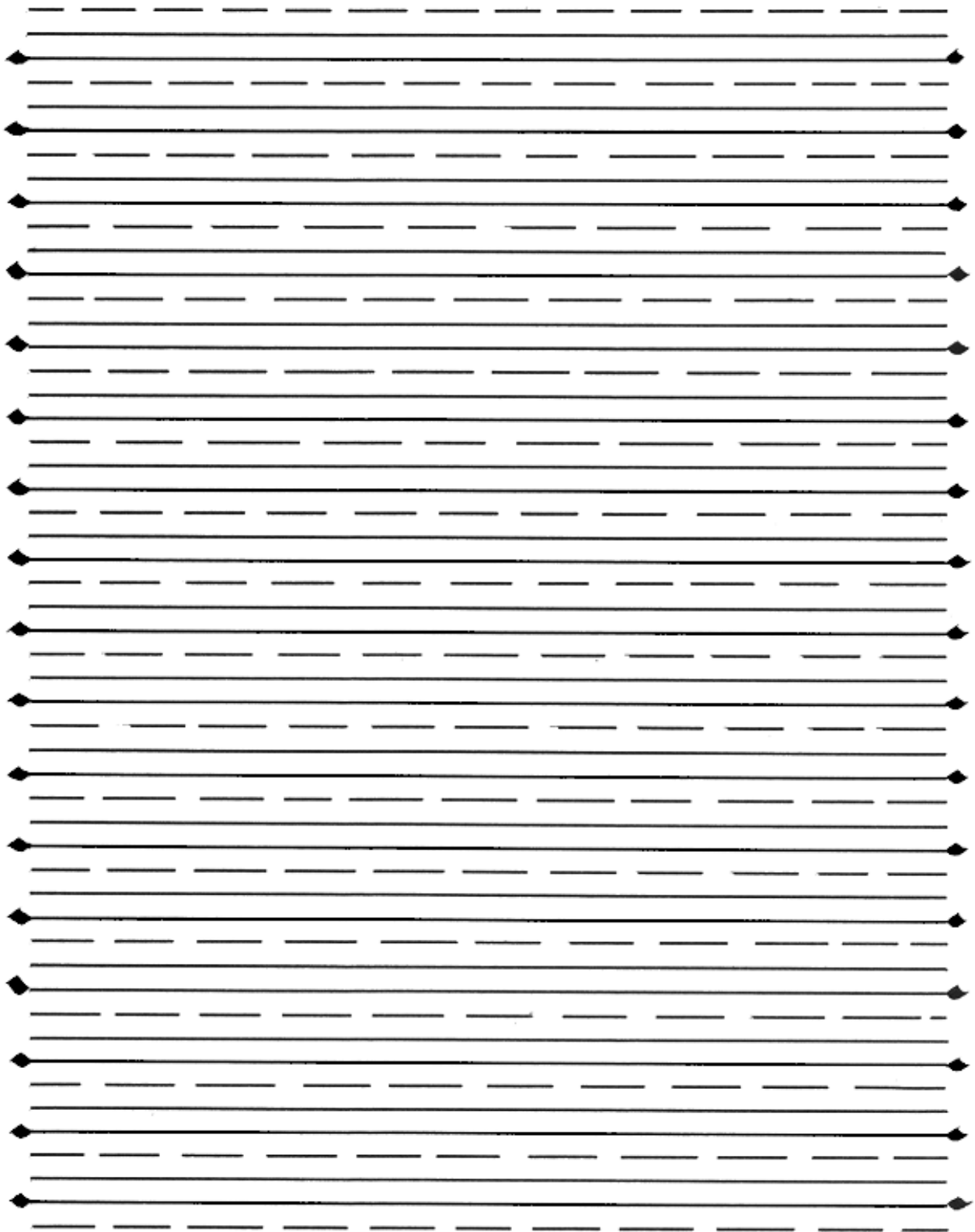
For additional practice, use this page as a guide underneath your paper.
